Word	Definition
Rules	an accepted principle or instruction that states the way things are or should be done, and tells you what you are allowed or are not allowed to do
Rights	those things that one is morally or legally entitled to do or have
Responsibility	something that it is your job or duty to deal with
Respect	admiration felt or shown for someone or something that you believe has good ideas or qualities
Talents	natural aptitude or skill
Unique	being the only one of its kind; unlike anything else
Lonely	unhappy because you are not with other people
Isolated	feeling unhappy because of not seeing or talking to other people
Include	to invite another person to be a part of something
Improve	make or become better
Communicate	to share or exchange information, news, or ideas
Solution	a means of solving a problem or dealing with a difficult situation
