Prior learning

Vocabulary and definitions

Word	Definition
Friend	a person who you know well and who you like a lot, but who is usually not a member of your family
Acquaintance	a person that you have met but do not know well
Conflict	a serious disagreement or argument
Solution	a means of solving a problem or dealing with a difficult situation
Consequence	a result or effect, typically one that is unwelcome or unpleasant
Bullying	repeated behaviour which is intended to hurt someone either emotionally or physically, and is often aimed at certain people because of their race, religion, gender or sexual orientation or any other aspect such as appearance or disability
Peer pressure	influence from members of one's peer group
Emergency	a serious, unexpected, and often dangerous situation requiring immediate action
Cyber bullying	a form of bullying or harassment using electronic means
Vulnerable	able to be easily physically, emotionally, or mentally hurt, influenced, or attacked
