Word	Definition
council	An advisory, deliberative or administrative body of people meeting regularly
vote	A formal indication of a choice between two or more candidates expressed through a ballot or show of hands
freedom	The power or right to act, speak, or think as one wants
Civil rights	The rights of citizens to political and social freedom and equality
biodiversity	The variety of plant and animal life in the world or particular habitat, which is considered to be important and desirable
endangered	(of a species) seriously at risk of extinction
individual	Of or for a particular person
political	Relating to the government or public affairs of a country
collective	Done by people acting as a group
responsibility	The state or fact of having a duty to deal with something or of having control over someone
