| Word | Definition |
|----------------|---|
| Culture | the ideas, customs and social behaviors of particular people or society |
| disability | A physical or mental condition that limits a person's movement, senses, or activities |
| race | Each of the major divisions of humankind, having distinct physical characteristics |
| tolerance | The ability or willingness to tolerate the opinions or behavior that one dislikes or disagrees with |
| multicultural | Relating to or containing several cultural or ethnic groups within a society |
| cooperation | The action or process of working together to the same end |
| prejudice | Preconceived opinion that is not based on reason or actual experience |
| sexism | Prejudice, stereotyping, or discrimination typically against women on the basis of sex |
| racism | Prejudice, discrimination directed against someone of a different race based on the belief that ones own race is superior |
| assumption | A thing that is accepted as true or as certain to happen without proof |
| discrimination | The unjust or prejudicial treatment of different categories of people especially on the grounds of race, age or sex |
