How do Jews remember Shabbat?

The Jewish day of rest, *Shabbat* in Hebrew, begins on Friday at sundown and ends on Saturday at nightfall. At the Friday night dinner, Jewish families transition from their everyday lives to a more spiritual time. Tables are elegantly set and families often sing traditional songs, engage in conversation, and share inspiring thoughts.

How do Jewish families and their communities celebrate Hanukkah?

Hanukkah is a <u>Jewish holiday</u> which celebrates the victory of the <u>Maccabees</u> over the larger <u>Assyrian</u> army. It also celebrates a <u>miracle</u> that happened during this time, where just a day's supply of <u>oil</u> allowed the <u>menorah</u> in the rededicated <u>Temple</u> in <u>Jerusalem</u> to remain lit for eight days.
